Thank you for choosing our Class C camper! To ensure you have a safe and enjoyable experience, please review and adhere to the following rules during your rental:

1. General Use Driver's License: The primary renter must be at least 25 years old and have a valid driver's license.

Authorized Drivers: Only the registered renters and drivers are permitted to operate the RV.

Smoking: Smoking inside the RV is strictly prohibited.

Pets: Pets are allowed only if previously approved. Additional cleaning fees may apply.

2. Safety and Maintenance

Seatbelts: All passengers must wear seatbelts while the vehicle is in motion.

Use of Appliances: Ensure all appliances are turned off when the vehicle is in motion.

Driving Hours: The RV should only be driven during daylight hours unless you have prior approval for night travel.

Weight Limits: Adhere to the vehicle's weight limit to avoid damage to the suspension or tires.

Towing: Towing is prohibited unless explicitly agreed upon in the rental contract.

3. Fuel and Mileage

Fuel: The RV must be returned with the same level of fuel as when it was picked up.

Mileage: There is a mileage limit for the rental period. Any overage will be billed at \$0.50 per-mile.

Waste Disposal: Dispose of waste properly and ensure that black and gray tanks are emptied before return. Failure to do so will result in a cleaning fee.

5. Camping and Parking

Campground/Overnight Parking: The RV must be parked in a designated RV spot in approved campgrounds or safe parking areas.

No Off-Roading: The RV is not permitted to be driven off-road or on unpaved paths unless on designated RV routes.

6. Emergency Procedures

Breakdowns/Accidents: In case of an accident or mechanical breakdown, contact the RV owner and RVShare immediately. Do not attempt repairs without prior approval.

Roadside Assistance: If included, ensure you know how to contact roadside assistance and the process for using it.

7. Return and Inspection

Return Time: RV must be returned on the scheduled return date and time unless prior arrangements are made.

Inspection: A thorough inspection will take place upon return. Any damages or cleaning issues will be assessed at this time.

8. Cancellations and Refunds

Cancellation Policy: Please review the cancellation policy outlined in your rental agreement. Cancellations made within [X] days of departure may incur a fee.
