General Trailer Operating Information

Stabilizing and Leveling Jack System

There's a common misconception that stabilizing jacks and leveling jacks are one and the same, but this is not the case. Their actual intended use is right in the name; **This trailer is equipped with stabilizing jacks** which keep the rig stable once it is parked for a solid, residential feel when you're inside. Although they are indeed capable of limited leveling of the trailer by lifting it an inch or two on one side, they're only designed to contact the ground enough to prevent unwanted movement, and not much more.

For leveling, this trailer has yellow block levelers to assist in the manual leveling of the trailer. Stack and Place levelers under tires as indicated in the picture below and pull trailer forward for up to a 6" rise. Place bubble level on the trailer floor to check level side to sided and front to back. Then place



wheel chalks under levelers to finalize the leveling.



Electrical "Shore" Hook-up 30 AMP

Once trailer is parked, you'll want to connect to "shore" power to prevent using your battery or propane. Hooking up the 30 AMP power will allow all appliances and lights to run on regular electricity. Electrical cord is located in the cupboard across from the stereo inside of the trailer; connect this cord from the trailer to the electrical post at the camp/trailer site. **DO NOT** forget to unplug and shore cored prior to leaving campsite.

Water Hook-up

The water hose is in the outside storage compartment inside the slide out. **USE THE WHITE HOSE!** Connect hose from trailer water to the port hook up at trailer/camp site. If you desire to use the water filtration device, make sure to connect inline between water spigot and hose. If there is no spigot for water, you can use a fresh water container and put hose inside container. Once you turn on water pump the water will be pumped from the container to sink or shower. **TURN WATER PUMP OFF AFTER USE!!!**

Beds

There are 3 sleeping areas. Two beds at each end of trailer and the dinette that converts to a bed.

<u>Linens</u>

Pillows, blankets and sheets are located under the left bench of the dinette. The beds have clean sheets/blankets on it at pick-up. Please do not return linen to this storage area! Towels and washcloths are in the pantry. Please leave linens on beds when you depart!

<u>Kitchenware</u>

You will find about everything needed to cook. Plates, bowls, cups, knife set, cutting boards and other miscellaneous items are in the drawer under the stove. Utensils, silverware, hand towels, mixing bowls, and pots and pans are in the drawer next to the stereo. Dish soap, sponges and other cleaning items are in the cabinet under the sink. PLEASE USE THEM ©

<u>Thermostat</u>

To control the interior temperature (heat only) use thermostat, located on the side wall of the stove. Note: Heat requires propane. Slide lever to the right for desired temperature. To turn off slide lever all the way to the left till lever is on (OFF)

Camping Accessories

A propane grill is located on floor at door entry.

.<u>Bathroom</u>

PLEASE DO NOT put **ANYTHING** in toilet other than RV toilet paper supplied by owners or purchased specifically for RV USE. Please be sure to open bathroom vent completely and run fan when shower is in use (to avoid mold or mildew).

To use the toilet, as long as there is water in the toilet water reservoir, press the blue button on toilet to fill the bowl with enough water to flush it. When you are ready to flush toilet, turn white lever to open the valve, this allows contents to flush into black holding tank.

Refrigerator

Refrigerator is powered by gas (propane), shore electricity (when connected) and 12V (battery power). Refrigerator will cool using the power source selected. To use propane, ignite pilot, turn the AC and 12V switches off, turn the left knob to high. While pressing down the left knob (while on

High) click the red piezo igniter switch up 10X's till pilot ignites. You can view the pilot through the pilot viewer to the right. This sometimes take 2-3 attempts. It is common for refrigerator to take 3-5 hours to cool when contents are first placed in them.

To power the refrigerator using 110v(AC), turn left knob to off. Then switch the green switch to the On (O), while making sure the red 12V switch stays off (I).

To power the refrigerator using 12V power make sure left knob is turned to off. Then switch the green switch to OFF(I) then switch the red switch to the ON (O) position.

<u>Keys</u>

The trailer has 4 main keys for the doors. Please keep them on you at all times! Cost of replacement keys will be deducted from deposit.
