

Tips for using RV (Sent via email)

1) WATCH YOUR CLEARANCE! IF YOU DON'T HAVE AT LEAST 12 FT OF CLEARANCE I WOULDN'T RISK IT!!

2) Have someone help you if you need to back up

3) Please do not drive faster than 70 mph. This is for your safety.

4) When trucks pass you you will likely feel a push in to another lane. When I see I'm going to be passed by a truck I lightly grip the wheel with two hands (10 and 2) and then GENTLY ease my way back to my lane.

5) You will likely average 7.5 – 8.0 mpg. Given the 55 gallon fuel capacity I would not go any further than 350 miles without refueling, I do 300 to be safe.

6) If you leave the fridge and propane on the fridge will use the propane. It's not a big deal for you to fill up, just letting you know.

7) The generator uses fuel so if you're running the generator while driving it will decrease your fuel economy. You'll need to run the generator to run the a/c for the cabin.

8) MAKE SURE THE A/C IS OFF BEFORE STARTING THE GENERATOR – THIS IS IMPORTANT AND IT'S CLEARLY MARKED ON THE A/C UNIT BY THE FAN CONTROL KNOB.
