- 1) WATCH YOUR CLEARANCE! IF YOU DON'T HAVE AT LEAST 12 FT OF CLEARANCE I WOULDN'T RISK IT!!
- 2) Have someone help you if you need to back up
- 3) Please do not drive faster than 70 mph. This is for your safety.
- 4) When trucks pass you you will likely feel a push in to another lane. When I see I'm going to be passed by a truck I lightly grip the wheel with two hands (10 and 2) and then GENTLY ease my way back to my lane.
- 5) You will likely average 7.5 8.0 mpg. Given the 55 galloon fuel capacity I would not go any further than 350 miles without refueling, I do 300 to be safe.
- 6) If you leave the fridge and propane on the fridge will use the propane. It's not a big deal for you to fill up, just letting you know.
- 7) The generator uses fuel so if you're running the generator while driving it will decrease your fuel economy. You'll need to run the generator to run the a/c for the cabin.
- 8) MAKE SURE THE A/C IS OFF BEFORE STARTING THE GENERATOR THIS IS IMPORTANT AND IT'S CLEARLY MARKED ON THE A/C UNIT BY THE FAN CONTROL KNOB.
