

Towing Declaration

I have been advised of the following: I know the travel trailer's dry weight (6845 Lbs.), empty tongue weight (690 Lbs.), and cargo-carrying capacity (1650 Lbs.). The trailer is 33 feet long and 11.5 feet tall.

I know the weight limits of my tow vehicle, including, but not limited to, towing capacity, GCVWR, and GVWR. I have researched my vehicle's capacities and am responsible for making sure my vehicle can safely tow this trailer, travelers, and cargo. I have been advised that I must have a working 7-pin trailer wiring connection with a hot lead. A 4-pin to 7-pin connector WILL NOT WORK.

Failure to have a working 7-pin connection will mean the rental may be canceled with NO REFUND. If I do not have a brake controller, a wireless one will be provided. Towing this trailer without a brake controller is not allowed. If the brake controller is lost, I will immediately replace it at my own expense. Towing this trailer without working brakes is against the law in most states.

In addition, if upon pickup, it is determined that your lights are not working, the trailer will not be sent out, and the rental will be canceled if you cannot get the connection working.

No Implied Warranty

While we do our best to provide a fully functional RV, things can and do fail. There is no implied warranty. Items not working are part of the experience of an RV trip. In case something stops working, your rental platform offers tech support over the phone. In addition, the owner may be available for phone support.

Renter is authorized to spend up to \$200 for any repair for a failed item without prior authorization from the owner. Cust is fully responsible for any issues related to tires, unless it can be proven that the tires are worn due to improper maintenance. Receipts must be available for reimbursement. Any amount over \$200 must be authorized. Failure to get authorization will lead to no owner reimbursement.

Any request for credit due to an issue will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis. Any credit will be based on verification that the item in question failed and the impact on the trip.

Cleaning

We take great pride in providing you with a clean RV. We hope you have a great time on your trip. When returning the RV, we simply ask that you sweep it out and wipe down all surfaces. If you rented any sheets, please strip the beds and leave the linens piled up on a bed. Please leave any towels hanging in the shower.

You are NOT responsible for washing the outside of the RV. Please remember to check the sinks and cabinets for any garbage or personal belongings. We are not responsible for any personal items left in the unit. We may, at your request, ship them to you, but you will be charged for all costs associated with this.

If the unit is returned dirty, we charge a cleaning fee of \$40 per hour with a one-hour min.

Additional Items & Rules

It has been explained to me that I MUST use the included Surge Protector, and failure to do so means I accept full responsibility for any damage caused by electrical faults.

It has been explained to me that I MUST use the included water pressure regulator, and failure to do so means I accept full responsibility for any damage caused by high water pressure.

The total weight capacity of the unit has been shown to me. I know that if I travel with a full tank of water, I am limiting the amount of cargo I can carry.

I have been advised not to exceed 70 MPH. The use of engine braking to limit wear on brakes has been explained.

I have been told how to use the provided wireless break controller. I have been advised it must always be used.

I have been advised to avoid cooking foods with a strong smell in the RV. In addition, no cleaning of fish. Whenever the stove top is used, I will turn on the vent fan.

I have been advised not to use the awning UNLESS I am around the RV. If I leave the RV, I will put the awning away. Failure to do so may lead to damage to the unit.

I have been advised that the unit is not to be taken off-road. (Dirt roads in the RV park are ok).

I have been advised that while GPS driving directions are of great assistance, I know that they may not always be accurate. I have been advised that I will be responsible for any recovery charges if I tow the unit somewhere that I cannot get it out of.

I have been advised that this is a no-smoking unit (including vaping), and any evidence found of such will result in forfeiture of the entire security deposit.

I have been advised to only use the provided toilet paper. If that runs out, I am to get RV/marine paper. No other type of toilet paper is allowed. In addition, the ONLY things that can go down the toilet are human waste, water, and the provided toilet paper. I have been advised that I may be charged \$50 per hour (1-hour min) if I misuse the toilet and cause a clog.

No Refunds for Early Returns: I have been advised that there is no refund for early returns. I have also been advised that my rental platform may offer trip protection insurance. Fee for Late Returns: If you are late returning the unit, there is a \$40 per hour late fee unless prior arrangement is made. Partial hours will be billed for full hours.

Off-Grid Camping

Please be aware of the limits of the RV while off-grid camping.

You will be limited in Power to what is in the batteries. You will not have AC, a microwave, or any working power outlets. The fridge will always draw off the battery. While there is a solar panel, it may not be enough to keep the battery fully charged if you use the trailer off-grid for a long period of time.

You will be limited to the amount of water in your fresh tank, and the amount of storage in the Black and Grey tanks. Please manage your water wisely.

You will be limited to the amount of propane. Propane will power your hot water heater, furnace, and stove. You may want to bring extra tanks with you.

You may want to rent a generator. If you do, please be aware that you may need a plug adapter for it to work with the RV. In addition to fully power this trailer please make sure your generator is big enough. If your generator is not big enough, you will be limited in what you can power at the same time. You accept all responsibility for any damage if you use a generator.
