

All coach mechanical systems are checked for operation before every rental and unless otherwise reported, are in proper working order.

The purpose of the LCI leveling system installed on the coach is to level the coach under reasonably level conditions. While “reasonably level” can be open to interpretation, our expectations of reasonably level are less than a 2° grade. Using a site with a grade of more than 2° is prohibited.

Failure to follow this rule will result in the over-extension of leveling jack leg(s). This will likely result in the 100 amp breaker switch being tripped. This will cause a “low voltage” fault in the leveling system, and it will require the renter to reset the breaker and relocate to a more suitable camping site. The circuit breaker is located behind the battery box.

The renter assumes all responsibility and costs associated with the improper use of the leveling jack system, to include costs associated with on-site repair services, and diagnostic costs and repairs post-trip.
