- 4. Extra supplies mentioned and or not mentioned in the inventory list.



CHASSIS:

- 1. DRIVE SLOW and STEADY.
- 2. HEIGHT CLEARANCE Watch your height.
- 3. GROUND CLEARANCE Driveways that have low clearance rear hitch guards.
- 4. EMERGENCY BREAKS. Always apply emergency brakes on steep hills.
- 5. 91 OCTAIN gas only (must show receipt full tank every 500 miles)
- 6. Park on LEVEL SITES do not park on hills.
- 7. Wide Turns, make WIDE TURNS to prevent damage and getting stuck.
- 8. Master Circuit Breaker. Make sure this is turned off when the RV is off.

SECURITY AND SAFETY:

- 1. Careful of kids falling out of windows.
- 2. Careful of theft in storage and compartments.
- 3. Careful of water /Fire/ Heat damage.
- 4. Television Must be in secured position prior to travel.
- 5. All items to be secured and put away position prior to travel.
- 6. Careful of Steep Driveway Ramps when driving.
- 7. Master Circuit Breaker. Make sure this is turned off when the RV is off.

CABIN/CHASSIS BATTERY:

- 1. Do not leave the battery on when parked. This will drain the batteries.
- 2. When DRY CAMPING keep the generator on and not just the batteries.
- 3. Always check and monitor your CABIN BATTERY LIGHTS.

BLACKWATER / SEWER SEPTIC:

- 1. Do not flush anything down the toilet except fesses and water.
- 2. Do not use the tank flush valve unless the tank termination valve is in the open position. *This can result in flooding and backflow of the RV and cause serious water damage.

GREY WATER / DISH, SHOWER, AND FAUCETS:

1. Do not leave the unit unattended while filling the tank. Overfilling the tank may cause damage to the RV.

GENERATOR:

- 1. Hold/press PRIME for a few seconds before starting the generator.
- 2. RV must be at least ¼ full gas tank for the generator to operate.
- 3. Generator should not be on while RV is plugged into the electric sockets
- 4. Gas Tank is only 91 octane and must have receipts.

ELECTRICAL:

- 1. This connection is for 110-125-VOLT ac, 60hz 30 Ampere supply. Do not exceed the circuit rating. Exceeding the circuit rating can cause a fire and result in death or serious injury.
- 2. Circuit Breaker provided. / Please use that to prevent short circuits and issues.
- 3. Make sure the generator is off when the RV is plugged into electricity.
- 4. Make sure circuit breaker to city is off, plug in power cord to breaker and RV's groove, gently turn it, screw it in and you should see a blue LED indicator light turn on.

AWNING:

- 1. Do not leave the awning unattended. Strong winds will rip off the awing and motors.
- 2. Lights by the awning are labeled.

BE CAREFUL OF WATER DAMAGE:

- 1. Overflow.
- 2. Ice chest.
- 3. Faucets.
- 4. Showers.

STOW AWAY - WHEN READY FOR DEPARTURE:

- 1. All exterior cabins, cables, and plumbing.
- 2. TV.
- 3. Kitchen supplies.
- Dining Table.
- 5. Bathroom, Showers.
- 6. Close cabinets inside the cab and outside the cab
- 7. Bunk Bed Items, Pillows. Etc.
- 8. All Items Secured.

PROPANE GAS:

- 1. This RV is filled with propane at the time of delivery/pickup.
- 2. Make sure Tank valve is turned on/off before using Stove or Heaters.
- 3. Blue Gas Switch On when using Stove.

POTABLE CLEAN WATER TANK/DOMESTIC:

- 1. Water tank is full at the time of Delivery / Pickup.
- 2. Do not use city water when the water tank is full.
- 3. Water Switch should be on only when using water.
- 4. Use the pressure regulator valve provided for domestic water.

EXAMPLES OF CHARGEBACKS:

- 1. Dealer Charges. Mechanical, electrical, plumbing, body, testing, etc.
- 2. Damages, Negligence, lost, stolen.
- 3. Tow, overage cleaning, refueling, late improper returns, overages, etc.
- 4. Black Water, Grey Water, Propane, smoke removal.

NOTES:

- 1. Please do not Power Wash RV. It will ruin paint and graphics.
- 2. Make sure water does not get into exhaust vents or openings.
- 3. Please pack lightly, the RV is equipped with most essentials.
