

Camping Trailer Rules



Occupancy

- No EXTRA PEOPLE allowed to stay than what you made your reservation for. Failure can result in extra charges.
- No KIDS unless previously agreed upon.
- No PETS or any animals.
- NO PARTIES
- NO SMOKING or Vaping or Any Marijuana. Sorry one of us is highly allergic. Please don't store it inside the trailer either. Feel free to do it outside or in your own vehicle.
- NOT a public bathroom. Our trailer is not a public bathroom and should only be used by who is renting the trailer.

Cooking and Dining

- Dinette will always be converted into sleeping area unless prior discussed and then we will have it converted into the dinette. But you must CHOOSE either or because we have a special heavy metal piece made for the bed. Moving it around is not something you want to be doing. It's way too heavy.
- Please keep hood fan on while cooking. Steam will make the fire alarm go off.
- Clean up food messes right away. Any spills not cleaned up you will be charged the extra cleaning fee.
- Wash tubs will be provided and all you have to do is put dishes into those tubs and no need to wash anything.

Food

- Please bring all your food needed.

Clothing and Towels

- There is storage for clothes above the bed and next to the bed
- NO Towels are included except for the floor if it rains and for the bathroom floor during showers. Please bring your own towels or arrange for us to accommodate you.

Hygiene

- Small amounts of body and hair soap will be included in shower but plan ahead if you would need more.
- Hand soap and cleaning supplies are stocked in the trailer for use.
- Wipes are also provided for personal use and the toilet. If you leave a toilet mess, please wipe it up.
- Please do not flush wipes. A small garbage is provided in bathroom.
- RV toilet paper is included. Please use a good amount of water when flushing as this helps when we go to dump everything.
- As Covid is still a concern sanitizer is provided in bathroom and kitchen area.
- We do not provide masks so please bring your own.
- If your rental is over 2- 3 days, please be aware that you will have to try to use campground showers and bathroom as our tanks are small and will not accommodate many showers or flushing.

Awning

- Please adjust pitch during rain.
- If it gets WINDY please bring in the awning and place items under trailer that you do not want to get wet.
- Mats can be left out in the rain

Bedding

- Any accidents that may affect the mattress or sheets bedding will result in a charge for a new one. This also includes the back sleeping area.

Refrigerator

- This will be pre-cooled and ready to go. It will be running off propane as this always guarantees that it will stay cool. Running off electric sometimes can be a pain to keep it cool enough.

Rain

- Included will be towels that you can put down at the door and outside to wipe your feet off on if it rains. This helps keep the trailer clean and less wear and tear done to it.
- Please close ceiling vents and turn off the fans as the rain will come inside through them.

- Please be respectful and clean in our awesome Shadow Cruiser trailer. This is our only trailer, and we are happy to share it with others when we are not using it.
