- 10.Always follow the owner's instructions regarding the use of equipment and appliances in the camper.
- 11.Please ensure that all lights and appliances are turned off when leaving the camper.
- 12.No open flames or candles inside the camper.
- 13.Do not move the camper from the designated location without prior consent from the owner.
- 14.Be mindful of weather conditions that may damage the awning. Damage caused to the awning may not be covered by your rental insurance and additional out of pocket expenses may occur.
- 15.The camper must be returned in the same condition it was received.
- 16.The waste tanks must properly be dumped/drained or a minimum fee of \$150 will automatically apply.
- 17.Any additional cleaning required beyond normal wear and tear will be charged to the renter's deposit.

MOREHEAD



1. Hiking: Twin Knobs offers several hiking trails, including the 2.5-mile Twin Knobs Loop Trail and the 7.5-mile Sheltowee Trace National Recreation Trail. These trails provide excellent opportunities to explore the natural beauty of the area.
2. Fishing: The nearby Cave Run Lake is a popular destination for fishing enthusiasts. The lake is home to a variety of fish, including bass, catfish, and crappie.
3. Boating: Visitors to Cave Run Lake can rent boats and jet skis for a fun day on the water. The lake also has several boat ramps for those who bring their own watercraft.
4. Hunting: The Daniel Boone National Forest surrounding Morehead offers excellent hunting opportunities, with deer, turkey, and small game abundant in the area.
