Camper Rental and Renter agree as follows:

1. CAMPER LIMITATIONS AND RENTER RESPONSIBILITIES

You certify that you agree to and understand the limitations placed on the number of persons permitted to occupy the Rental, and unless prior notified and agreed to by the owner you will abide by such limitations. Above Renter is at least 25 years of age and will be an occupant of the unit during the entire reserved period. The above Renter understands and agrees to that the owner is not responsible for or held liable for any injuries, medical conditions, or unforeseen issues that may arise during your reserved period. It's the Renters responsibility to ensure that the tow vehicle is rated and capable of pulling the camper. The Renter is responsible for all and any problems that may arise with the Renters tow vehicle.

- 2. PICKING UP YOUR RENTAL: Renter will need at least 45 minutes to check out the Camper the first day of the reservation. This allows time for orientation of all aspects of the unit you have reserved. This will also include a full walk through with the owner. NOTE: Any issues or concerns need to be addressed at this time. If you are a first-time camper, please let the owner know up front and additional time can be allowed. Pick up time is 10:00 AM the first day of your reservation, however special arrangements can be made with prior communication if needed.
- **3. RETURNING YOUR RENTAL:** Rentals are due back by 3:00 PM on your scheduled day back. Late returns without prior approval will result in additional charges. Upon return the Renter and owner will do a complete walk through the camper. The same principle applies for Owner, any issues noted must be addressed at this time and if noted at a later date cannot hold Renter responsible.
